

The Pacifica Education Foundation (PEF) is an all-volunteer nonprofit, founded in 2008, that works to ensure that students across the Pacifica School District have equitable access to enriching music, the arts, and science programs beyond the core curriculum. During 2025-26, community support sustained core music and arts programs while expanding hands-on science opportunities districtwide.

MUSIC

Music education for elementary students

For the fourth consecutive year, PEF funded one of two elementary music teachers, along with all program supplies. Weekly instruction reached every TK-5 student across PSD's five elementary schools, providing hands-on learning in instruments, vocal performance, music notation, and theory. In 2022-23, PEF support also expanded the program to TK-2, extending music education beyond its original focus on grades 3-5.

Middle School Band

PEF continued supporting middle-school band programs at Ingrid B. Lacy Middle School and Cabrillo School, funding the practical needs that make participation possible, including instruments and repairs, sheet music, summer band, and field trips.

THE ARTS

SPARC Poetry: Giving students a voice

PEF funded SPARC Poetry (Stage Performance + Rhythmic Culture) for all fifth graders districtwide — a weekly workshop over 26 weeks that builds writing, performance, and social-emotional skills.

SPARC reports that across their Bay Area programs, **82% of students write about overcoming obstacles and cultivating personal strength.**

SCIENCE

Science from Scientists: Hands on STEM

2025-26's biggest expansion: Science from Scientists (SciSci) now reaches all 6th graders at IBL Middle School and Cabrillo School, with trained scientist-educators leading bi-weekly hands-on STEM lessons connecting classroom concepts to real-world problem solving.

PEF provides roughly half of the program funding with other SciSci donors providing the funding for the balance of the program costs.

SciSci reports that across the nearly 100 schools it serves nationwide, **87% of students demonstrate increased STEM confidence and are more engaged in science after the SciSci program.**

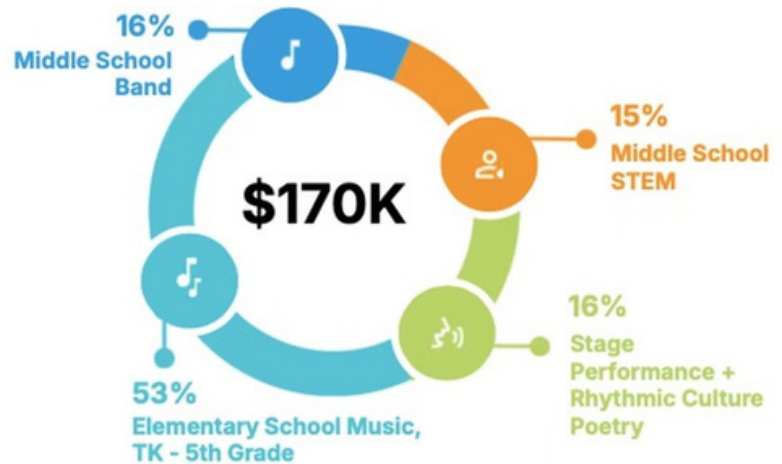

Pacifica School District is the 2nd-lowest-funded (per student) among San Mateo County's 17 elementary/middle-school districts — a \$24,600 gap versus the top-funded district, making community support essential.

Why this work matters

PEF bridges the gap between public funding and what Pacifica students need for a well-rounded education. Our districtwide model expands equitable access while strategically leveraging community support to extend the reach and impact of available public funding.

Looking ahead

Next year, PEF's focus is to sustain its existing music, arts and science programming, and expand where funding can make the greatest difference — including extending the hands-on Science from Scientists program to 3rd–5th grade at all five elementary schools.
